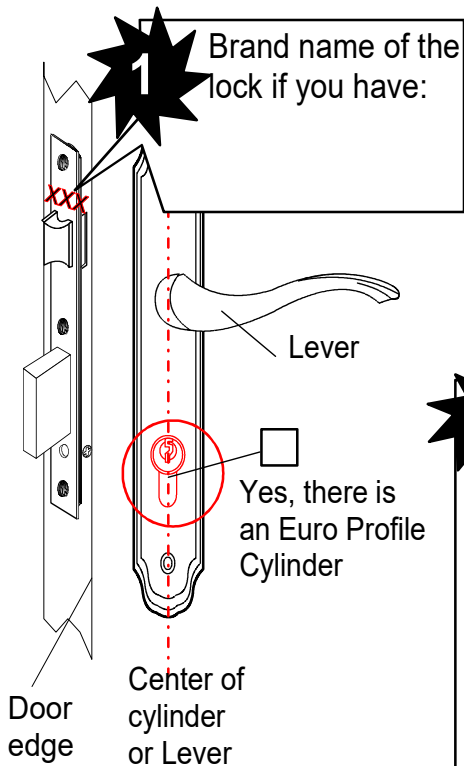

2 Finish/color of Faceplate

When Deadbolt is thrown/locked, I can open the door from inside by operating the Lever only.
 When Deadbolt is thrown/locked, I must unlock the Deadbolt by cylinder and then operate the Lever to open the door from inside

3 Size of Faceplate
 Width= _____ mm

7 Hub / Spindle size
 Measure the size of the Hub or Spindle(= the square steel bar adapted to the Lever)

4 Finish/color of Deadbolt / Latch



6 C to C /Measure the distance between the Center of the Lever and Cylinder
